

# Fact Swap

## Description

What better way to assess students' understanding of a concept presented than to have them record facts they have learned? The twist on this assessment is that students also have an opportunity to learn from their classmates as they swap facts they also learned!

## Materials

- Fact Swap sheet, 1 per student

## Teacher Preparation

Prepare Fact Swap sheets, 1 per student.

## Procedure

1. Distribute a Fact Swap sheet to each student.
2. Encourage each student to record three different facts learned from the lesson just completed.
3. Students will move around the room trading their facts with six other students in the room following the guidelines below:
  - ✓ A student must trade a fact to receive a fact in one of their boxes.
  - ✓ Each student should record their initials by the fact they swap.
  - ✓ A student may only receive one fact from a student.
  - ✓ Each fact on the sheet must be different.



Write 3 facts related to what you have learned today in the first 3 boxes. Then find 6 more facts by trading one of your facts for another's facts. You need 9 different facts when you are finished.
